Delivery and Collection

Each entry is to be delivered in a padded bag clearly labelled with the entrant's name and title of work by 4.00pm Tuesday 12 September 2017. A swing tag with the entrant's name and title of work should be pinned or tied to the piece. This will be replaced by an entry number for judging so that the judges do not know who has entered each piece. Do not write your name on the piece.

Members are responsible for the postage and insurance (if required) both to and from the Guild. The collection date for items after display will be advised in July/August when gallery arrangements for the redeveloped building have been finalised.
