Think and work like an artist exploring ideas and themes, and translate these into finished works using favourite media.

Have you had a burning desire to tell a story with your stitching? Are you fascinated by historical events, human experience, nature, images, words or other sources of inspiration?

Artists look at what is happening in the world, take small fragmented pieces and combine them into a coherent story. Viewers of artworks are intrigued by and will remember a work if it communicates an idea, creates an experience or leaves a lasting impression.



Learn how to think and work like an artist, how to generate ideas and translate those ideas into finished works using relevant media. Explore a theme of your choosing by brainstorming, simple design and drawing exercises, analysing examples of Collection textiles, library research, and visual diary work and experimentation using a variety of materials and methods of expression.



Examples of the tutor's research based installation exhibition work will be shown. Student handouts will be provided.
