Metal thread work presents us with a variety of interesting and regionally focussed ways to plan and apply metal threads in embroidery. Sharyn is continuing to offer different facets to metal thread techniques in a series of individual one-day workshops.

In September, **or nué** is a technique that heralds from Europe in the Middle Ages where opulent and shiny laid gold threads were couched down with coloured silks. The effect of changing the density of the couching stitches gives rise to a 'shaded gold' effect. Contemporary design gives a new life to a well-established technique.
