This pretty, small dragonfly is stitched on linen fabric using fine gold purls - 'Pearl' and 'Bright Check' - to outline the dragonfly and to use 'chipped' for the thorax and the head. The wings are of tambour thread and are stitched to provide a light, transparent, vein-like quality. The tail is formed of a line of bugle beads. Other beads are used to decorate the body and the wings.

The overall design measures 9 cm x 6.5 cm. All the materials required are offered in this course as a pre-packaged kit (\$10) containing the linen, felt, metal threads and beads etc
