# Parisienne Lace

Welcome to a class that takes geometric smocking into a new direction by creating the delicate curves and floral accents of French lace. The option of two samplers provides the opportunity for you to start with a less intense project if preferred, while learning the intricacies of making 'curves and lace' using basic smocking stitches.

Although we will be stitching on a pleated and blocked band of fabric using silk threads, pearls and ribbon to create tones of colour rather than a bold contrast, these stitches can be easily transferred to a garment for child or adult, or your sampler inserted into a cushion or other useful project such as a bag or iPad cover.

We will work on the basic principles on Day-1 with a small amount of homework in preparation for Day-2. The second day provides the opportunity to learn the finer embellishing stitches which make your work come to life.

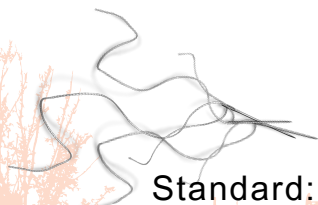
