

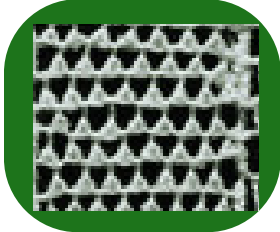

Kenmare Needle Lace is a traditional flat needle lace developed and taught in 19th Century Ireland.



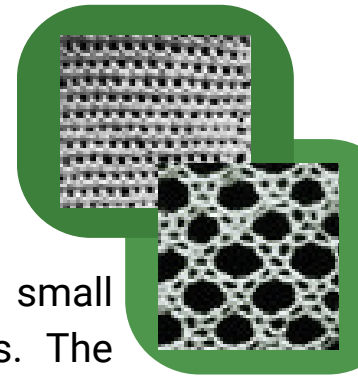

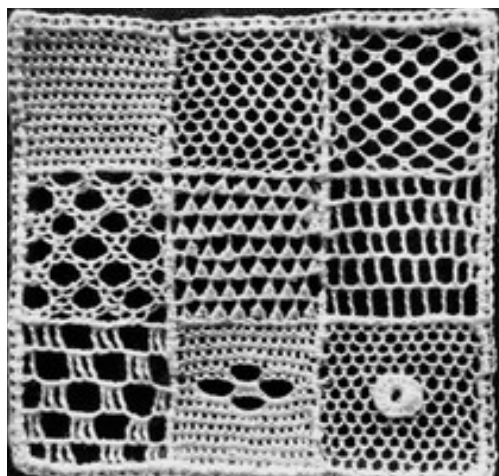
2 Days - Workshop



Kenmare Needlelace



In this workshop Jo will be teaching students to create a small needle lace sampler of Kenmare Needle Lace stitches. The samplers consists of a laid cordonnet of nine squares with a different stitch in each square. These stitches are : Chord stitch, Brussels Point, Double Brussels Point, Pea Stitch, Shell Stitch, Chord Stitch with Diamond, Treble Spanish Point and Pops.
